- Have embedded the School Games Values within their intra school PE, School Sport and Physical Activity provision.
- Have a notice board and/or in house school digital system that promotes School Games activity and uses social media for the same purpose.
- School have engaged with parents/ carers during the Covid-19 school closures to ensure pupils access regular physical activity at home
